



## POSTERS' SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

All posters will be on display from Tuesday, May 15<sup>th</sup> as from 8:00 a.m. until Thursday, May 17<sup>th</sup> at 6:00 p.m. Posters left after that date and time will be discarded.

**IMPORTANT: Please note that your poster number corresponds to the assigned summary number through the Conference platform.**

- The organization will provide a poster template; however, its use is not mandatory.
- The posters must be presented in vertical format (portrait).
- The size of the poster should be 0.80 cm wide and 120 cm high.
- The poster must be handed in upon registration on site at the Conference Secretariat at the National University of Piura.
- Each poster will be stuck on a numbered board with the same summary number assigned through the platform. The organization will take care of placing them in the assigned space with double sided tape.
- The organization will indicate the time schedule in which the author must be next to his poster for its presentation.

### Recommendations:

- Avoid overloading your poster with too much information.
- Dispose information in a clear and logical manner.
- The text, including legends, figures, symbols and graphics, etc., must be large enough to be legible at 140 cm distance.
- Diagrams and photos are extremely useful and necessary to show results and conclusions.
- Make sure your illustrations are easy to understand; do not overload any graphic or drawing with information.
- Use dark text colors on a light background and easy-to-read fonts.
- It is recommended that the title be on font size between 80 - 100 pt.
- It is recommended that authors and institutions be on font size between 30 - 40 pt.
- It is recommended that the main text be on font size between 32 - 40 pt. or in case you have a large amount of text between 24 - 28 pt.
